The score is divided into two systems. The first system covers measures 30 to 40, and the second system covers measures 45 to 50. The instruments are Double Bass (D.B.) and Piano (Pno.).

System 1 (Measures 30-40):

- Double Bass (D.B.):** Measures 30-39. Measure 30 starts with a *p* dynamic and ends with *mf*. Measure 40 starts with *p* and ends with *p*. A **P. 20** (Piano) dynamic marking is present above measure 40.
- Piano (Pno.):** Measures 30-40. Measure 30 is marked **P. 30** (Piano). Measures 31-32 are marked *mp*. Measures 33-34 are marked *mf*. Measure 40 is marked *p*. A **P. 20** (Piano) dynamic marking is present above measure 40.

System 2 (Measures 45-50):

- Double Bass (D.B.):** Measures 45-50. Measure 45 starts with *f*. Measures 46-47 are marked *mf*. Measures 48-49 are marked *ff*. Measure 50 is marked *f*.
- Piano (Pno.):** Measures 45-50. Measure 45 is marked *mp*. Measure 46 is marked *p*. Measure 47 is marked *mf*. Measure 50 is marked *f*.

Additional markings include *Red.* (Reduction) and asterisks (*) in measures 34, 40, and 46. A crescendo hairpin is shown between measures 45 and 49.
