Notes of the editor:

- 1) I The right hand (M. D.) forms a loose fist and strikes the strings with the fingernails so that they strike the frets (percussive effect). The following rasgueado is played directly out of this position.
- 2) II Each window represents one unit. The progression consists of a constant repetition and increase of the amount of windows until the respective "measure" is completed.
ex.:  etc.
- 3) Vento (Wind). p, i, m scratch the bass strings with the fingernails. A relative change of pitch is produced through a fast-slow movement.
- 4) Tambora e (little finger) on the bridge.
p over the soundhole on the soundboard.
- 5) A-go-go-(cow bells)
The strings are crossed at the respective fret.
- 6) The unit should be further repeated.
- 7) Arpin (little harp)
Rasgueado or single tones between nut and mechanik.
- 8) M. D. strikes tambora on the bridge. M. S. (left hand) varies the relative pitch through an opening and closing of the soundhole (with the palm of the hand).
